I'On Radio: Testing on AM 1640 and/or 1710

Yes, it's true. I'On now has its own radio station! I'On Radio is a community radio station focused on the activities and interests of people living in and near I'On. I'On neighbors will largely supply the content. The latest BizNet project is the most ambitious (and arguably the most fun) yet. **Mike Balister** is supplying the technical expertise, and the signal is currently being tested on AM 1640 and/or 1710, so listen in when you have a chance. It will ultimately have a clear range of approximately 1 mile from I'On Square.

Test messages and content will begin to get filled in over the month of August as we fine-tune the equipment, learn the software, and move the antenna to its permanent location for the 'official' target launch of September 1st. Most of the content will be completed by mid-August. The charter-advertising sponsors are 20 BizNet members.
