### **I'On Radio: 1640 AM**

The BizNet Radio Station project picked up steam in August, and is now ready for your listening pleasure, on both your AM radio at home or in your car, as well as on the Internet which has crystal clear reception anywhere in the world!

I'On Radio is a community radio station focused on the activities and interests of people living in and near I'On. I'On neighbors will largely supply the content.

The station antenna is based in I'On Square. Since by definition this is a low-powered community radio station operating under FCC rules part 15 we cannot exceed a power level of one tenth of a watt. The publicly licensed Charleston radio stations run 5000 watts: 50,000 times the power of our station.

The useful range of the signal is deemed to be a 1 mile radius from I'On Square, and we have tips for best reception on the [www.ionbiznet.com](http://www.ionbiznet.com) website...or simply logon from any computer connected to the Internet and enjoy the station that way.

**East Cooper Montessori Charter School News**, submitted by **Anne Kendrick, ECMCS Governing Board President**. The school year has officially begun at ECMCS with sixty-six eager and excited first- through sixth-graders! In May 2005, the Charleston County School Board approved our request to expand the charter to allow for enrollment of 150 students, grades 1 to 8, and if all goes according to plan, we should have our school building complete and be up to enrollment capacity by Fall 2007. As you all should know by now, ECMCS is a public, Charleston County school and all elementary-age children in Charleston County are eligible

for enrollment. We are at full capacity for our space and have a waiting list for the 2005-6 school year, but we encourage I'On families with elementary-age children to consider us as we continue to grow.

We have a long way to go, but we would not be where we are today without the generosity and commitment of I'On Development and the support of the I'On community. We now have seven I'On families enrolled at ECMSC and several I'On residents who serve the school as community board members, public relations consultants, and teachers. Thanks to all who have joined us in our goal of offering the East Cooper community another choice in public elementary education!
