## **I'On Assembly Corner - Notes & Meetings**

**Landscaping & Infrastructure Meeting - April 26th at 7 PM at I'On Realty, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor board room.** Interested neighbors are welcome. **More Lots/More Commercial Space proposed by I'On Group – The I'On Group** presented a preliminary proposal to the **I'On Assembly HOA Board** on **February 28<sup>th</sup>**. The **I'On Group** wants to apply for changes to the zoning-like regulations that define the scope of **I'On**, e.g. a **Planned Development (PD) Amendment**. They want to increase the total number of lots in **I'On** by 38 lots (+5%) in a new **Phase 11**, increase the amount of commercial space in **I'On** by 6,000 sq ft (+20%) to finish out **I'On Square**, and rezone a few scattered Commercial and/or Civic lots to residential. The **HOA Board** shared a number of concerns about the original Phase 11 plan, including serious concern about further stressing our lack of on-street parking in areas with one-way streets. The **I'On Group** came back at a special HOA Board meeting on **March 15th** to discuss a revised plan, to address a number of concerns the HOA Board had shared, as well as some input received by homeowners. The March 15th discussion was encouraging, but is still continuing. Details of the latest proposal from the developer are available on [www.ioncommunity.com](http://www.ioncommunity.com). Any changes will ultimately have to be approved by **Mt. Pleasant Town Council**, but the developer will not apply for the changes until the HOA Board is fully aligned with the plan. A meeting to gather broad community input to the plan is being considered.

**Walk 10 miles on I'On's Trails on April 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup>** - The new **West Walk** trail will officially open on the weekend of **April 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup>** as part of a series of three walks totaling ten miles on both of **I'On's walking trails**. The guided walks will be free. These walks commemorate **I'On's 10th anniversary**. Children capable of making the walk are welcome. Large sections of both trails are on soft mulch or gravel surfaces. Guest guides will contribute to the experience along some of the walks. The event will end with a recognition program for those walkers who have completed all ten miles. The event will begin at **Bodacious Bagels** in the **BI-LO Plaza** on **Shelmore Blvd.** at **9 AM** on **Saturday, April 28<sup>th</sup>** with a guided tour of **East Walk I'On**, the original 4.2 mile trail which opened in 2002. This tour will cover the **Eastlake Neighborhood, Rookery, I'On Square, the Marshwalk and Shelmore**. Beginning at **2 PM** on **I'On Square** at **357 N. Shelmore Blvd.** there will be a 2-mile tour of some of the walkable area between **I'On** and **Highway 17**, including the nature reserve between **I'On** and **BI-LO Plaza** and the **Muirhead/Hobcaw roundabout**.

On **Sunday afternoon, April 29<sup>th</sup>** at **2 PM**, there will be a tour of **Westwalk I'On**. This new 3.82 mile trail covers the Western half of I'On, including **Perseverance Park, the historic graveyard, Indian campsite, Westlake, Avant Garden, the Amphitheater and Holy Ascension Church**. The **West Walk I'On** is **GPS-enabled**, meaning an electronic route file can be downloaded which allows walkers to navigate the trail with satellite guidance.

**April 11<sup>th</sup> Open House Party and Information Night 5:30-8 PM** at the **Creek Club** for all **I'On residents**: Event discussion from **6:15-7:00 PM**.

**On April 21st**, the third annual running of the **I'On Village Circuit Bike Race**, a nationally-sanctioned bicycle race, will be coordinated by **Event Chair, Dr. Alan Comen (I'On Health)**, with a small army of volunteers and representatives of the **Mt. Pleasant Police Department**.

Everything will be centered on **Maybank Field**, including the **Start/Finish line**. The event is presented by **I'On BizNet, Inc.**, I'On's nonprofit community business association, in co-operation with **Junior Achievement** and the **Low Country VW Racing Team**.

The highlight of the day will be a series of bicycle races sanctioned by the **U.S. Cycling Federation** and now the cornerstone of the South Carolina Championship weekend here in Charleston. The races will begin with youth and amateur divisions earlier in the day. As the day goes on the races get longer and faster, leading up to the final race between professional, sponsored teams, where speeds exceed 35 miles per hour on **Ponsbury Road** and other straight-aways. The bike racers universally love the course.

Some of the best vantage points are around the course at the various corners, or simply walking the course while the races are going on to catch all the action. **House and porch parties along the course are welcomed and encouraged.** **ION Radio** will be broadcasting live all day, with announcements, race results interviews and updates right from **Maybank Field**. We'll also be dropping in on porch parties and reporting right from the race course. Tune in on your boom box at **AM 1640** or on the web at [www.ionradio1640.com](http://www.ionradio1640.com) .

## **SPEED LIMITS REMOVED & I'ON STREETS CLOSED APRIL 21<sup>ST</sup> FOR BIKE RACE**

We all know that '20 is plenty in I'On'...but not on **April 21<sup>st</sup>**. Authorized by special permit from the **Town of Mount Pleasant**, from **7 AM to 6 PM** the speed limit for selected streets in I'On will be removed entirely for the **I'On Village Circuit Bike Race**, where speeds will exceed 35 miles per hour. More details about all the exciting events of the day, organized by **I'On BizNet**, are covered in further articles.

The condition and authority of the permit is that the streets be closed to traffic, and completely cleared of any parked vehicles during the race hours.

**Therefore, the following streets will be closed to traffic** and must not have any vehicles parked on the street, from **7 AM to 6 PM on Saturday, April 21<sup>st</sup>**:

- **North Shelmore** from Sowell to Ponsbury
- **Ponsbury** from North Shelmore to Sowell
- **Sowell** from Ponsbury to North Shelmore

During this time there will be very limited access onto and across these streets, so please plan accordingly. Expect delays of up to an hour if you want to use or cross these streets at all, and no vehicles will be allowed to park on the streets during these hours. Street access procedures and maps are available on the event website.

Any vehicles parked on the route at **7 AM** will need to be removed (towed if necessary) to setup the safety bales and secure the course.

All other streets in **I'On** will remain open as normal...with normal speed limits...although extra traffic can be expected. Please consider parking your car outside of the race course before Saturday morning if you'll be directly impacted by the route.
