What is Suspicious Activity?

Basically, anything that seems slightly “out of place” could be criminal activity and should be considered suspicious activity. Some things to watch for are listed below.

- A scream heard anywhere may mean a crime is being committed.
- Anyone seen peering into parked vehicles may be looking for a car to steal or for valuables left displayed in the car.
- Any vehicle moving slowly and without lights, or driving around without any apparent destination. The vehicle may be casing the neighborhood to commit a crime.
- Someone inspecting or entering your neighbor’s home while your neighbor is away.
- Someone running from a home or business under unusual circumstances.
- The sound of breaking glass or other loud explosive noises could mean an accident, a house being broken into, or vandalism taking place.
- Persons loitering around schools, parks, secluded areas or in the neighborhood.
- Individuals soliciting door to door without proper licenses and identification.
- A stranger offering a child candy or some other gift
- Notify the Police immediately of any suspicious persons or activities. Call 884-4176, or call 911, explain it’s not an emergency and ask to be transferred to the Mount Pleasant Police.
