## 2016 Programming and Activities

The I'On Trust is very pleased to report that we have concluded another successful year of events and activities in line with our mission of bringing neighbors together. ## **Financial Information**

The Board of Directors of the l'On Trust, along with its Executive Director, oversees the management of the organization and works closely to ensure that nonprofit best practices are always in place. On a monthly basis the Executive Committee including the Treasurer and President review the income/expense actuals and each quarter financial reports are made to the full board. On November 14th, our Board of Directors approved a 2017 budget of \$92,548 and further agreed the net loss of \$8,598 would be covered by the cash surplus accrue from transfer fees that exceed budget expectations in previous years. Transfer fees for the l'On Trust, as stipulated in the founding documents, are one tenth of one percent of every home sold. This fee income is the primary source of funding for the l'On Trust.

With the financial agreement of 2015 with The I'On Assembly Board of Trustees, The Trust has not needed any financial support from the Assembly since 2014. The Trust has been able to fund programming for 2015 and 2016 with transfer fees as well as some cash surplus from prior years. In the event that The Trust would require assistance outside of income provided by transfer fees, The Assembly has made arrangements to support The Trust should it be needed.
