

THE CIVITAS AWARD

Civitas is the Latin word for Citizenship – especially as imparting a sense of shared responsibility, a common purpose and sense of community.

For those of you who don't know, The Civitas Award was created in 2003 to recognize individuals within the I'On Community who have provided outstanding community service to make I'On a better place to live.

While many volunteers are needed to keep I'On running the way it does, this award recognizes those few individuals who go above and beyond the call. Not just on one occasion, but usually several, over many years. Often times, their body of work isn't particularly glamorous or even that obvious, but it is constant and makes a significant contribution to the betterment of I'On.

The recipient of the award is selected by a committee made up of a representative from the I'On HOA Board, the I'On Trust, and the 4 prior recipients. There may come a year where no one is honored, there have been years where two recipients were chosen.

This award is not won. It is earned.
