

Signage Policy

Per Article III Section 3-103: *“(c) Signs: No rules shall regulate the content of political signs; however, rules may regulate the time, place and manner of posting such signs...”*. Therefore, political signs may be placed on homeowner’s lots during an election season and shall not be placed more than 2 weeks prior to the election and must be removed within 2 weeks following the election.

If political signs remain on lots longer than 2 weeks following an election, the Covenants Committee will begin the violation process to have them removed.

This is to certify that the Board of Trustees adopted the Signage Policy by unanimous consent, effective March 18 2024, until such date as it may be modified, rescinded or revoked.
