- household garbage
- plastic bags (shopping bags, cereal bags, trash bags)
- styrofoam packaging or food containers
- food waste
- yard waste
- bulky plastic items (i.e. toys, hangers)
- batteries
- light bulbs
- electronics
- clothing and shoes
- construction debris (i.e. wood, insulation)
- shredded paper
- plastic wrap (i.e. thin plastic food wrap or shrink wrapping/product packaging)
- rope-like items (i.e. garden hoses)
- medical waste (i.e. syringes)
- diapers or sanitary products
- propane tanks
- aluminum foil and trays
- motor oil and cooking oil
- paint
- empty aerosol (spray) cans
